Skate Canada Section Volunteer Coach Award

Criteria:

- An active professional coach who is currently registered with Skate Canada with a minimum NCCP Level 1 certification;
- An individual who contributes volunteer time in addition to professional coaching time at the club, region, Section or national level;
- A professional coach who espouses the passion, spirit and triumph of skating to other coaches, athletes, volunteers and officials; and
- A professional coach who has demonstrated commitment to the development of the sport of figure skating at all levels (i.e. CanSkate, STARSkate, Competitive Skate, etc.) through volunteer activities.
