Criteria:

- Active and currently registered adult volunteer whose efforts have produced specific, positive results within and outside his/her respective Section;
- An individual whose contributions reflect passion for the sport and its participants;
- An individual who is an exemplary role model for other volunteers, skaters, coaches etc., and who leads by example;
- Long-term commitment (minimum of 10 years volunteer work in the sport of figure skating), awareness and interest in the future direction of the sport; and
- Past winners of this award are not eligible for re-nomination.
