Standard for Coaches: Coaches must be NCCP Regional Coach In-Training and be a paid Skate Canada member for the current year and in good standing.

Age Verification: Birth certificates may be required. It is recommended that the Team Manager be in possession of the birth certificates to verify the age of a team member in case of dispute. The Team Manager will certify the dates of birth upon registration.

Cancellation of Event: The host committee reserves the right to cancel any event due to insufficient entries.

Refund Policy: Registration fees will be refunded only if the event is not held or if the entry is withdrawn before the registration deadline. There will be a \$25.00 administration fee applied to all refunds. After the closing date of entries, there will be no refunds given unless supporting medical documents are provided.

Registration: Team Managers must register all team members by the deadline date, February 18, 2023. There will be a \$20 fee per category charged for failing to submit a PPC or MP3 file by the deadlines stated. Teams will not be permitted to register at the competition until this fee has been paid and a PPC sheet along with a MP3 music file has been submitted.

On-site Registration:

All teams, coaches and team managers must register on-site at the Credit Union Place. Registration on Sunday, March 12 will begin 1 hour prior to the start of the first scheduled practice or event.

Only those skaters whose names appear on the team registration form as team members/alternates will be permitted to skate. No substitution or addition shall be allowed. The number of allowable alternates on each team is four.

Planned Program Sheet (PPC): Completed forms must be submitted by February 18, 2023, in a PDF format only (screenshots of the PPC will not be accepted).

Music: Music (MP3 file) must be submitted online no later than February 18, 2023. One CD or USB must be submitted at the time of registration. Music should be clearly labeled on the CD as well as the case, indicating the name of the team, the event and music length. CD/USB's should be picked up as soon as possible after the event.

SCORING:

1. Juvenile to Adult III categories will be marked in CPC for their programs and each team will receive a report card.
2. Star 3 will be assessed to a standard for their program and will receive an overall assessment of Gold, Silver, or Bronze. Star 4 teams will receive a ranking based on their assessment to standard.

NOTE: There will be a draw for skating positions done by the host committee and data specialist for each part of this event. This will be done prior to the event and posted in the arena.

SCHEDULE: A finalized schedule will be forwarded to each team manager as soon as possible after the closing date. Such a schedule will also be available at www.skatecanadapei.ca.

AWARDS:

Ribbons:

- Star 3 teams will be presented a gold, silver, or bronze ribbon for each event based on assessment to standard.

Medals:

- Star 4 teams will be ranked based on their assessment of their free program and medals shall be presented to the top three teams.

Juvenile to Adult III: medals shall be presented to the top three teams.

All presentations will be held on the ice surface.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

For more information visit Skate Canada's team composition rules. Any team entered in an age restricted categories for which they are not age-qualified shall be disqualified and not permitted to change categories after the start of the competition. Entry fees shall not be refunded.

- ✓ All team managers and chaperones must be current Skate Canada registrants.
- ✓ Two coaches, one team manager and two chaperones for a total of five people per team will be accredited. The names and Skate Canada numbers for these accreditations MUST be included on the online registration form.
- ✓ The main coach and one alternate (skater) will stand at the entrance to the ice, and the team manager and other alternates in the exit area.
- ✓ The chaperones will be allowed in the dressing rooms ONLY and will not have access to ice level during practice and competition (including Kiss & Cry).
