Overview

This document has been developed to provide recommendations for Clubs, Coaches, Skaters and members, for the necessary precautions with the intention to limit the spread of COVID-19.

Health related matters are associated to the Public Health Guidance of the PEI Chief Public Health Office (CPHO)

Program capacity will be dependent on the facility requirements and the ability to have an appropriate ratio of skater to coach/PA/administrator that minimizes the contact and allows for a quality program delivery.

Operational Requirements

- Clubs are required to complete an operational plan – it should be submitted to Skate Canada PEI, and will be required for any PEI government inspection
- All Skaters and members **must** sign the COVID-19 waiver before they participate in a skating program
- Attendance tracking of all attendees (including spectators) **must** be completed for each session, daily
- All clubs and programs must be prepared to provide a daily screening for symptoms process before participation
- It is recommended that there is a separate entrance and exit onto/off surface for all members to follow

Program Delivery Guidelines

- All programs must comply with physical distancing, cleaning and sanitizing measures and recommendations by the PEI CPHO
- Cleaning supplies must be provided by the club for all program equipment (teaching aids, harness, music devices, etc.)
- Coaches and PA's are highly recommended to wear a non-medical mask
- Synchronized Skating is allowed but masks are recommended due to frequency of proximity to others and # of contacts on team
- Pre-CanSkate is not recommended for this season unless it is a Parent-Assisted program (Parents will need to pay Skate Canada membership)

Club Considerations

- Develop refund policies should stay-at-home orders occur for a Covid-19 individual case or program cancellations
- Designate an on-site emergency person, must be a Skate Canada member
- Create a communication strategy for COVID-19 exposure (designate a person who will contact CPHO, Skate Canada PEI office, how will members be notified, who speaks publicly, etc.)
- Perform all registrations and payments electronically to minimize in-person contact
- Minimize number of contacts for the music system

Positive Case

- Child's name will not be identified but the club/school will need to provide list of contact tracing promptly for the identified session(s)
- It will not be the organization's responsibility to phone the contact list – the Health PEI nursing team will do all the contact tracing phone calls
- If contact is named as a 'close contact' from a positive contact they will need to self isolate for 14 days
