



Call for Applications: 2027 Canada Winter Games (Head/Assistant Coach)

Dear Coach,

The 2027 Canada Winter Games are fast approaching, and Skate Canada PEI is seeking interested coaches to fill the roles of Head Coach and Assistant Coach. The 2027 Canada Winter Games will be held in Quebec from February 26th to March 15th, 2027. Figure Skating is generally scheduled for the second week of the Games.

Coaching Qualifications

- All coaches must complete the following three NCCP Competition-Development (Comp-Dev) multi-sport modules:
 - NCCP Managing Conflict
 - NCCP Leading Drug-Free Sport
 - NCCP Manage a Sport Program
- Figure Skating Coaches must hold a minimum of NCCP Provincial Coach (Comp-Intro) certification, in addition to completing the three Comp-Dev modules listed above.
- Special Olympics Coaches must hold a minimum of NCCP Regional Coach (Comp-Intro) certification, along with the same three Comp-Dev modules.

Coaching Responsibilities

- Participate in the Training Team selection process.
- Assist in planning, scheduling, and execution of training sessions.
- Attend all training sessions.
- Accompany the team to identified competitions (e.g., Standard of Performance event, Fall 2026 competition, etc.).
- Assist with final team selection.
- Attend the 2027 Canada Winter Games.
- Perform other duties as determined by Skate Canada PEI from time to time.

In accordance with Canada Games guidelines, all Canada Games staff positions are volunteer and cannot be financially compensated.
